Mr. Poatsy offered a brief description of what was planned for the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Town Hall meetings to be held at Salford Hills Elementary School on Wednesday, February 3, 2010 and Thursday, February 11, 2010 at 7:30 p.m.

- Tom Brown thanked the Board for their efforts made to notify the public of the meetings. He also mentioned inconsistencies mentioned in an article posted in The Reporter with regard to sewage connection costs.
