

February 9, 2010

The regular February meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman Poatsy at 7:30 p.m. Messrs. O'Donnell and VanLuvanee were present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr.

The following reports were presented for the month of January 2010: Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company and Township Solicitor.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. VanLuvanee, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the hiring of Leonard Welch and Mike Saeger to offer part-time assistance on an as-needed basis for snow plowing.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. VanLuvanee, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the appointment of Neil Saunderson as a member of the Upper Salford Special Fire Police.

A brief update was offered by Mr. O'Donnell on the Township's process of looking into outside funding with regard to the Salford Station Road Bridge replacement.

The Board of Supervisors announced that the February 11, 2010 Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan meeting to be held at the Salford Hills Elementary School was being cancelled due to the weather forecast. It was suggested that attempts be made to reschedule the meeting for the following Thursday, February 18th, provided that the school is available.

The agenda for the Multi-Park Board meeting agenda was discussed. The meeting will be held at the Township office on February 23, 2010 at 7:30 p.m. The public was invited to attend.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. VanLuvanee, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of February in the amount of \$98,579.58 for payment.

The receipts for the month of February totaled \$60,117.64.

The Treasurer's report as of February 9, 2010 noted the following amounts: total assets-\$4,452,602.44, total liabilities-\$2,081,633.88 total equity-\$2,370,968.56. Total liabilities and equity equal \$4,452,602.44.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. VanLuvanee, the minutes of the January 4, 2010 Board of Supervisors meeting were approved as submitted.

Public Comment included:

- Brian Gwiazdzinski questioned if the Township would apply for federal relief for the expenses relating to the snow storms.
- Following the Solicitor's report, Roger Richter questioned if THP had appealed to the Supreme Court.

The meeting adjourned at 7:46 p.m.
