A joint meeting of the Upper Salford Township Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission was brought to order by Chairman O'Donnell at 7:30 p.m. Messrs. Poatsy, Hagey, Giannini, Raisner, McMaster and Nase were present, as was the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms Jr., Township Engineers, Jeff Kerlin and Michael Reinert, and Sanitary Engineer Consultant, Fred Ebert. Mr. Sacks was absent.

The amendments and appendices to the **draft 537 plan**, which included the draft Ordinance establishing regulations for the installation, inspection and on-going maintenance of on-lot sewage disposal systems, were reviewed. Various suggestions and comments were made by the Planning Commission members and Board of Supervisors.

Public comments regarding the draft ordinance were made by Roger Richter, Tom Brown and Barbara Gormley.

Public comments regarding location of the sewer district areas were made by Mark Krupp and Roger Richter.

Public comments with regard to the expansion of the existing sewage treatment plant were made by Roger Richter.

A consensus of the Board of Supervisors authorized the Township Engineer to submit the draft 537 plan to outside agencies for review after appropriating text changes brought forward by the Planning Commission; however, the township will continue to discuss areas of contention during the subsequent joint meetings. A courtesy copy of the draft would be sent to DEP for their informal review and input.

The discussion of **goals for future projects** of the joint board was tabled until the May Joint meeting with a request that suggestions be sent to the township secretary to be compiled into a list and distributed to all members of the joint board.

A consensus of the Board authorized the Township Solicitor to **advertise Ordinance 2009-1** for adoption at the April 14, 2009 Board of Supervisors meeting.

The minutes from the March 4, 2009 Joint meeting were unanimously accepted as submitted.

Mr. O'Donnell announced that the joint meeting work sessions will revert back to the advertised schedule, which is the first Tuesday of each month beginning in May.

The meeting adjourned at 10:39 p.m.
