

June 14, 2011
Salford, Pennsylvania

The regular June meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman O'Donnell at 7:30 p.m. Messrs. Poatsy and Sacks were present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr.

The following reports were presented for the month of May 2011: State Police, Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company, Upper Salford Special Fire Police, Lower Frederick Ambulance, Green Lane Ambulance, Zoning Officer, Building Inspector, Park Board, Road Superintendent, Township Solicitor, and Indian Valley Regional Planning Commission.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously adopted **Ordinance 2011-3**, clarifying the established weight limitation and restrictions for the public use of **Shelly Road**.

Public questions and comments included:

- Roger Richter questioned the police enforcement of the ordinance.
- Paul Schneider questioned whether fire trucks were exempt from the weight restrictions.

Members of the Folk Song Society; Andy Braunfeld, Nancy Kolkebeck, Alex Kohr and Michael Cloeren, attended the meeting to discuss the 50th annual **Philadelphia Folk Festival** to be held August 18, 2011 to August 21, 2011.

Public questions and comments included:

- Barbara Gormley questioned if the Fire Company would have a place in the beer tent again this year and requested a parking pass.
- Terry Smith questioned whether Salford Station Road would be opened prior to the Folk Festival.
- Neil Saunderson commented on the back-up parking plan used last year and requested early confirmation on the alternate parking sites.
- Terry Smith questioned whether there was a charge to enter the beer tent.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the Board's execution of the **Memorandum of Understanding** for the 50th annual Philadelphia Folk Festival to be held August 18, 2011 to August 21, 2011 in Upper Salford Township. Mr. O'Donnell requested that the Board be included in the State Police meeting prior to the Festival as they were last year.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the 23rd annual **Red, White and Blue Parade** to be held on July 4, 2011 and authorized the use of Township equipment, such as barricades, cones and radios, at the parade.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Poatsy, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to request assistance with traffic and crowd control on Thursday, August 18, 2011, during the arrival

of campers for the **Philadelphia Folk Festival** from the following Fire Police Units: East Greenville Borough, Green Lane Borough, Limerick Township, Lower Salford Township, Pennsburg Borough, Perkiomen Township, Red Hill Borough, Salford Township, Schwenksville Borough, Souderton Borough, Skippack Township, Towamencin Township, Trappe Borough Upper Frederick Township.

The motion further authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to request assistance with traffic and crowd control at the **Old Goshenhoppen Church** 134th annual Oyster Picnic to be held on Saturday, September 10, 2011 from the following Fire Police Units: Salford Township, Green Lane Borough, Red Hill Borough, Skippack Borough, Schwenksville Borough, Lower Salford Township, East Greenville Borough and Upper Frederick Township.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously authorized the **Upper Salford Special Fire Police** to assist with traffic and parking at the **Rob Schaefer Memorial Classic Soccer Tournament** to be held on August 14th and 15th at the Upper Salford Park, if they so choose and have the volunteers available. The Board did not want the event to restrict residents' access to the park.

It was the Board of Supervisors' desire to have a letter sent to the residents by the end of June giving them an update on the pumping requirements of Ordinance 2011-1 and to supply them with a list of registered pumper/haulers along with information on how to maintain their on-lot sewage disposal system and ways to identify malfunctions.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of June in the amount of \$443,819.15 for payment.

The receipts for the month of June totaled \$135,960.23.

The Treasurer's report as of June 14, 2011 noted the following amounts: total assets, \$5,942,404.39, total liabilities-\$2,000,262.81, total equity-\$3,942,141.58. Total liabilities and equity equal \$5,942,404.39.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the minutes of the May 10, 2011 Board of Supervisors meeting as written.

On a motion made by Mr. Poatsy and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
