

July 19, 2011
Salford, Pennsylvania

The regular July meeting of the Upper Salford Board of Supervisors was brought to order by Chairman O'Donnell at 7:30 p.m. Mr. Sacks was present, as well as the Township Solicitor, Stephen P. Imms, Jr. Mr. Poatsy was absent.

Mr. O'Donnell made the following announcements:

- Raven Hill would be performing in the Upper Salford Park on Thursday, July 21st at 7pm as part of the summer concert series.
- The review of the 537 Sewage Facilities Plan would be starting up again in the near future, possibly in the next month.
- The Township intends to begin work on Salford Station Road where the wooden bridge was removed on Monday, July 25th.

Comments from the public:

- Mark Beck asked if the Fire Company could put something on the Fire House sign to advertise Thursday's concert.

The following reports were presented for the month of June 2011: Upper Salford Volunteer Fire Company, Upper Salford Special Fire Police, Lower Frederick Ambulance, Green Lane Ambulance, Planning Commission, Zoning Officer, Building Inspector, Park Board, Road Superintendent, and Township Solicitor.

During the Fire Company report, Fire Chief Paul Schneider requested that the Township pass a ban on burning due to the lack of rain and excessive dryness.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the October 9, 2011 Ride Ataxia 2011 bike ride to raise funds for Freidrich's Ataxia research. The Board 's concerns with Bergey Road would be passed on to the event's program director, as well as the requirement to notify the State and County of the event since both State and County roads would be used during the ride.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved **Resolution 2011-6**, declaring a burning emergency which would ban all burning within Upper Salford Township until further declaration of the Board of Supervisors.

Questions from the public included:

- Mary Gibbs Kershner questioned when the burning ban would become effective.
- Gary Larson asked if the Folk Festival would be notified of the burning ban.

On a motion made by Mr. O'Donnell and seconded by Mr. Sacks, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the bills for the month of July in the amount of \$98,198.23 for payment.

The receipts for the month of June totaled \$60,431.13.

The Treasurer's report as of July 19, 2011 noted the following amounts: total assets, \$5,632,684.97, total liabilities-\$1,717,484.05, total equity-\$3,915,200.92. Total liabilities and equity equal \$5,632,684.97.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the minutes of the June 14, 2011 Board of Supervisors meeting as written.

On a motion made by Mr. Sacks and seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, the meeting adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
